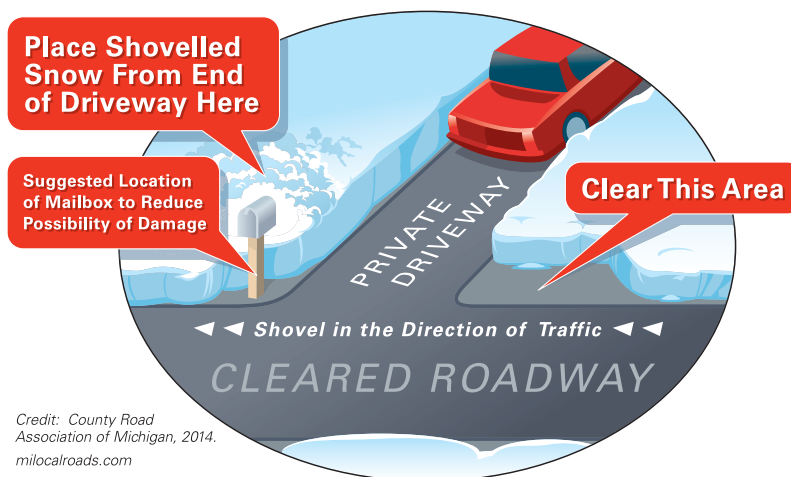
### Avoid the “Second Shovel”

**Lansing, Mich.** – As yet another winter storm is predicted, the County Road Association of Michigan released an infographic to help Michigan residents avoid the frustration of the “second shovel.”

“Shoveling snow once after a storm is already a tedious process and one Michigan residents have had enough of this year” said Denise Donohue, director of the County Road Association of Michigan. “Having to shovel a driveway a second time after the snowplow passes is just frustrating.”

The County Road Association offers a few simple guidelines that will help people avoid that frustration. By clearing an area before your driveway large enough for the snow coming off the blade to be deposited (to the right as you face your home or business), you can avoid the “second shovel.”
