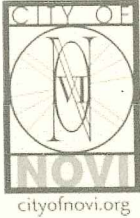

As you can see from my Resume', I have had a broad range of experiences which have provided me with skills which, I believe, could facilitate my role as Council Member.

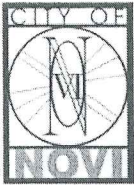
In particular, I have ...

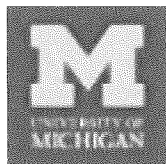

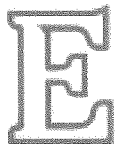
