NOVI CEMETERY

The Old Burial Ground donated by area pioneer Daniel Lee provides a final resting place for many of Novi's earliest settlers.

In 1844, remains from graves on the Loren Flint Farm, some dating from the early 1830's, were transferred to this one-acre site.
