**SUBJECT:** Approval to award a construction contract for ITC Pathway Phase 1A to L.J. Construction, Inc., the low bidder, in the amount of \$640,980, subject to final review and approval of form of agreement by City Manager's office and the City Attorney; and approval of an additional appropriation in the amount of \$117,000 from the Municipal Street Fund for this budget line item.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

This project will consist of an approximate 1.65 mile long, 10-foot wide, asphalt pathway between ITC Community Sports Park and Garfield Road (see attached location map). The entire Phase 1A portion of the path will be located along the ITC transmission corridor or ITC property.

The project was bid as a base bid and one alternate. The base bid includes construction of the pathway from ITC Community Sports Park through the ITC corridor to the Garfield Road crossing. Alternative 1 continues the path from the Garfield Road crossing to Nine Mile Road (see attached location map). The alternate was included to give flexibility at the time of award to accommodate varying levels of available funding. Staff recommends awarding the base bid at this time based on the availability of funding for this project.

A total of 7 bids were received and opened on February 17, 2016 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is L.J. Construction, Inc. L.J. Construction's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., L.J. Construction has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price. (URS's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated February 18<sup>th</sup>, is attached). A summary of the 7 bids is as follows:

\*Crew Days are included to compare bids, but are not included in the award.

The construction bid and the construction engineering fees (located elsewhere on this agenda for consideration) are \$640,980 and \$78,139, respectively, for a total of \$719,119 to be awarded. The amount budgeted for this project is \$662,437, of which \$27,134 has been awarded for design engineering, leaving a remaining balance of \$635,303. In order to fund the project, a budget amendment in the amount of \$117,000 is needed from the Municipal Street Fund for the award amounts and material testing to be awarded in the future. The proposed budget amendment utilizes \$75,000 in additional revenue that is proposed by the developer of Dunhill Park for the Eight Mile Pathway along its frontage, and \$42,000 of additional interest income in Municipal Street Fund to offset the additional expense.

Construction of the project will commence this spring with completion anticipated in fall of 2016.

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Approval to award a construction contract for ITC Pathway Phase 1A to L.J. Construction, Inc., the low bidder, in the amount of \$640,980, subject to final review and approval of form of agreement by City Manager’s office and the City Attorney.

Location Map

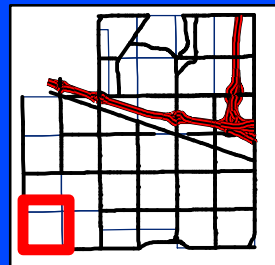

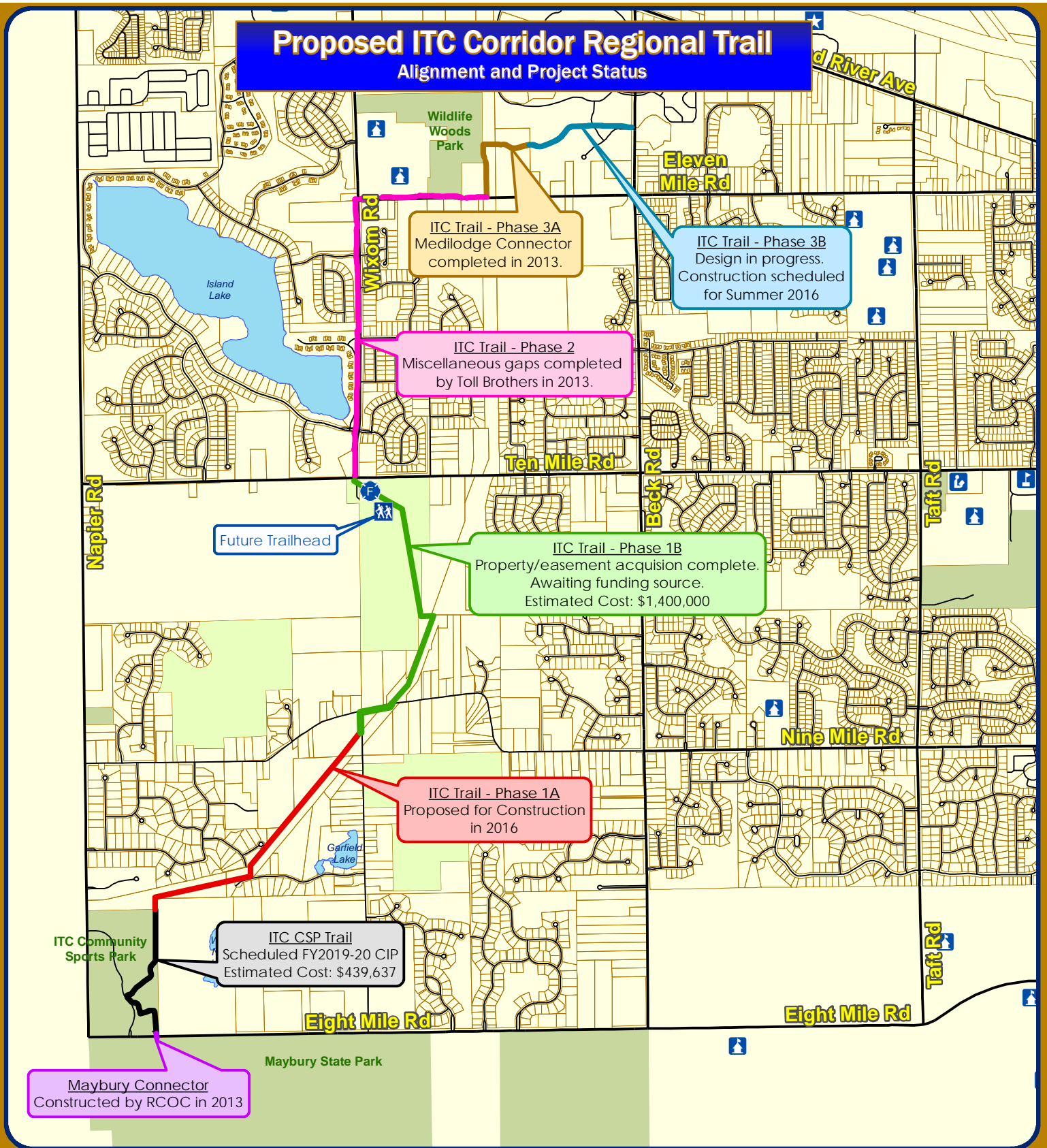

Dear Mr. Wayne:

Attached is the Bid Tabulation for the above referenced project. Seven bids were received and opened. Competition appears to have been very good and the low bid is under the latest Engineer's Estimate. The following irregularities were noted in the bids:

There were minor mathematical errors in the second, fourth, and sixth lowest bidders. After correction of the errors, there is no change in the order of bidders. The fifth lowest bid, from M-K Construction, acknowledged receipt of Addendum 1 but they failed to use the revised Bid Form included with Addendum 1.

L J. Construction, Inc., the low bidder, has completed numerous similar projects in the area. We contacted some of the references they provided and they have performed satisfactorily on these projects. The bonding company listed in the Statement of Qualifications has an AM Best rating that exceeds the minimum requirements.

We recommend award of the Base Bid contract to L J. Construction, Inc. for the Bid Amount, excluding crew day costs, of \$640,980.00. If budget is available, the award amount including both the Base Bid and Alternate 1 would be \$704,585.00.
