SUBJECT: Approval to purchase twelve (12) sets of protective turnout gear for the Novi Fire Department from Phoenix Safety Outfitters, an authorized dealer for LION, who holds the National Purchasing Partners (NPP) cooperative purchase agreement for \$45,394.20.

SUBMITTING DEPARTMENT: Public Safety – Fire Department

KEY HIGHLIGHTS:

- This is for the annual replacement of firefighter turn-out gear (full-time and parttime) on a 10-year cycle
- This is not related to the turn-out gear purchased from the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity (LEO) Grant, which was for an additional set of gear for full-time fighters only
- Replacement included in annual uniform budget within the General Fund
- Turn-out gear inspected on an annual basis

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA 1851) Standard limits structural firefighting turnout gear ensemble components to a maximum service of ten (10) years from date of manufacture. This standard, and the manufacturer's recommendation, suggests that after ten (10) years of service, all components, including turnout coats and pants, be removed from service and no longer used for structural firefighting. The moisture barrier within the bunker gear begins to fail after each successive fire the gear is exposed to. Likewise, the outer shell can absorb harmful carcinogens and is continually subjected to cuts, tears, and abrasions during normal use at a structure fire. The Department currently inspects and washes bunker gear on an annual and as-needed basis, according to the Standard. In addition, we will send gear out for necessary repairs when needed, thereby extending its useful life to the ten-year period.

The Novi Fire Department has a standardized replacement schedule for these coats and pants. A new set of gear is purchased for new hires. The replacement of the turn-out gear has been included in the annual uniform budget for the 2024-2025 fiscal year. Phoenix Safety Outfitters is an authorized distributor for LION and holds an NPP Cooperative purchasing contract.

SUBJECT: 2024 TURNOUT GEAR

DATE: SEPTEMBER 6, 2024

The firefighter's turnout gear is one of the most essential pieces of equipment a firefighter has. The three main components of turnout gear are the coat, pants, and suspenders. Turnout gear is very complex each piece contains a fire-resistant outer shell, a thermal layer, and a moisture barrier each of these components must meet criteria outlined in the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA 1851) standards for fire firefighter turnout gear.

Each set of turnout gear is inspected and cleaned after every fire, as well as annually. This proactive approach ensures that any problems or damage found can be repaired or replaced as needed. The criteria used to determine if turnout gear is ready for replacement is as follows; if the turnout gear is 10 years old, damage to the thermal layer, or improper fit.

The Novi Fire Department Purchases Lion appeal turnout gear the local distributor, Phoenix Safety Outfitters using the existing National Purchase Partners (NPP) contact #1915. National Purchase Partners (NPP) contracts are competitively solicited by a lead Public Agency in accordance with government purchasing regulations. These contracts include "Piggybacking" language, allowing utilization by NPP government members nationwide this gives the City of Novi a 35% discount off the list price of turnout gear.

The Novi Fire Department purchases Lion V-force sets of bunker gear every year based on the three criteria listed above. the National Purchasing Partners price for the lion v-force is \$3707.85 per set the department is looking at replacing 12 sets of gear this year. Also included in the quote are 12 bunker coat name plates at a cost of \$75.00 per tag The total cost of 12 sets is \$45394.20 after approval Phoenix will come in and measure the Firefighters that are getting replacement gear to insure proper fit.
