### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Each year, the City of Novi selects residential streets for reconstruction, repaving, repair, and/or rehabilitation based on PASER ratings, staff's field observations and resident concerns. City staff worked with our consultant, URS Corporation (AECOM), to develop a list of streets for the 2016 program. Contract 3 (Asphalt) includes rehabilitation and reconstruction of selected segments of Clark Street (PASER 2/5), Durson Street (PASER 2), Marlson Avenue (PASER 2), and Stassen Avenue (PASER 2) in Novi Heights Subdivision; and Cortland Boulevard (PASER 3) in the Orchard Ridge Estates (see attached map).

A total of three bids were received and opened on August 11, 2016 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is Pro-Line Asphalt Paving Corp. Pro-Line's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., Pro-Line Asphalt Paving Corp. has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price. (AECOM's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated August 12, 2016 is attached). A summary of the three bids is as follows:

\*Crew Days are included to compare bids, but are not included in the award.

Construction of the project will begin this summer and be completed this fall. The construction engineering award is proposed for consideration elsewhere on this agenda.

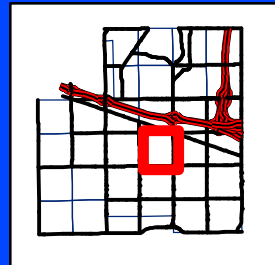

Attached is the Bid Tabulation for the above referenced project. Three bids were received and opened. This bid is under the latest Engineer's Estimate. The following irregularities were noted in the bids:

There are minor arithmetic errors in the next low bidder, Cadillac Asphalt LLC's bid. These errors did not impact the overall bid order.

Pro-Line Asphalt Paving Corp, the low bidder, has successfully completed similar projects in the City of Rochester Hills, City of Plymouth, Macomb County, and Oakland County. The bonding company listed in the Statement of Qualifications (Great American Insurance Company, Guy Hurley Blaser & Heuer, LLC is the agent) has an AM Best rating that exceeds the minimum requirements.

We recommend award of the Neighborhood Roads HMA Contract 3 to Pro-Line Asphalt Paving Corp for the Bid Amount, excluding crew day costs, of \$623,496.67.




